Environmentally Responsible Wood Procurement Policy

Tenon Clearwood LP is committed to managing its business in a responsible manner including environmentally responsible procurement of wood.

Tenon Clearwood LP's processing site located in Taupo, New Zealand has received Forest Stewardship Council (FSC®) Chain-of-Custody certification, demonstrating that it procures wood which meets strict environmental, social, and economic standards.

This policy for wood procurement is adhered to by all manufacturing operations in New Zealand owned by Tenon Clearwood LP, and is applied to all wood procurement activities.

Only wood from sustainable sources is purchased for processing, remanufacture, and on-sale.

Sustainable sources of wood include:

- Wood sourced from Forest Stewardship Council (FSC®) certified sources
- Wood sourced from sustainable tree farms that are managed in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, and which meet the FSC® Controlled Wood Standards (FSC-STD-40-005)

We will not procure wood which has been:

- illegally harvested or from trade in illegal wood or forest products
- harvested in conflict with traditional or human rights
- harvested from natural forests, high conservation value or environmentally-sensitive areas
- harvested from natural forests converted to plantations or non-forest use
- produced from genetically modified trees
- produced in violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions, as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work
